The ICTI Certificate in Training programme starts with a one week Training of Trainers workshop 11-15 February 2013 at Springhead Park House, Rothwell, Leeds.

If you are already competent in your professional skills, and are called upon to train others this training event is for you! *The course has no formal subject specialism content* and so is relevant to anyone seeking to provide high-quality training.

In the course you will explore:  
Characteristics of adult learning - Motivation of adults - Leading discussions - Handling feed-



back - Running exercises and simulations - Visual aids and handouts - The learning environment - Running a session and developing session plans - Group dynamics - Evaluating training

The ICTI Training of Trainers workshop includes practical sessions. You will practice teaching skills in small groups.

The trainers for the Training of Trainers workshop are Andrew Steele and Christopher Singh. Andrew is Executive Director of ICTI with many years experience training Christian trainers in Africa, Asia and Latin America, Chris is Training Consultant for Radio Worldwide and has trained around the world.

The cost for the course is tailored to those who are participating and kept to an absolute minimum.

Participants can obtain the ICTI Certificate in Training providing you with recognition of your work as a trainer and matching your work with other recognised training qualifications.

*The full price for the course is £249 for the full week including lunches and refreshments. Bed, breakfast and evening meal is available for £120 for six nights arriving 10th and departing 16 February.*

*A discount of £25 is available to staff of registered charities and non-profits and a further £25 discount to staff of ICTI members organisations.*
